DRI seizes 83MT of areca nut in Mundra

Ahmedabad: A team of Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) seized 83.3 metric tonnes (MT) of areca nut, valued at Rs 5.7 crore, from the Mundra Port. The stock was declared as base oil in related import documents, said officials. Origin of the cargo was UAE. Acting on the intelligence, the containers were examined by the officers of DRI Ahmedabad Zonal Unit. During the course of examination of the containers it was found that there were in all 738 drums of which 658 drums contained areca nuts in split form, while 80 drums contained Oily liquid purportedly 'Base Oil' used for concealment of the drums containing Areca nuts in each container, mentioned a note from DRI, adding that oil worth Rs 6 lakh was also seized.

Pre-board exams for Class 10 begin

Ahmedabad: Pre-board exams began from Saturday for about 46,000 students in the city who are in Class 10. According to the schedule fixed by the state education board, the exams will last till February 6. The students were to appear for a test on January 29, but the exam was cancelled on that day because Prime Minister Narendra Modi is to discuss the issue of examination with schoolchildren on that day in his programme 'Pariksha pe Charcha'. The exam that was scheduled on January 29 has now been rescheduled on January 30. In Ahmedabad's 552 schools, 46,107 students registered themselves for the tests, but 45,580 students appeared on the first day of exams. 3 jailed for keeping child in bondage in Ahmedabad



AHMEDABAD: A special Pocco court here sentenced three members of a family to three years in jail for keeping a five-year-old boy in bondage with the observation that their offence was "inhuman and inhuman".

Three persons — Mohammed Akram Shaikh, his wife Sayrabanu and daughter Alice — were held guilty of beating the child and of offences under the Juvenile Justice Act.

They have, however, been acquitted of charges under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (Pocso) Act, which police had invoked during their investigation. Special Pocco judge, S I Tarani acquitted three other members of the family for lack of evidence against them.

According to the case details, a five-year-old boy came to the Shaikh family after his parents' divorce. The family had employed the father at his powerloom unit in Rakhal. The father-son duo soon began living on the factory premises. After a few days, the Shaikh family took the boy home, promising his father that they would take care of him and his schooling. He was sent to madrasa for a while.

Five years later, the father remarried and decided to get the boy home. The Shaikh family allegedly resisted. It took the intervention of others for the father to secure the child's custody. The child had been complaining about ill treatment, but the father did not bother initially. Once the child was in his custody, he filed a complaint with Isanpur police accusing the family of assault, criminal intimidation and abetment. Six members of the Shaikh family were booked under Sections 323, 506(2) and 114 of the IPC. During the investigation, police added charges under Pocso and the Juvenile Justice Act as well. Before the court, the child narrated how he was beaten and forced to work in the house. Besides the witnesses' testimonies, the court also had a video showing the Shaikh couple making the child toil and then beating him with their daughter standing nearby. The injury marks on the child's body substantiated his allegations of torture. The court found that the father's conduct did not inspire full confidence about his truthfulness and acquitted three members of the family following articles recently.

Three of family jailed for keeping child in bondage Ahmedabad's special Pocco court sentences three family members to 3 years in jail for keeping a 5-year-old boy in bondage. The court finds them guilty of beating the child and offenses under the Juvenile Justice Act. Charges under the Pocso Act are dropped, while three other family members are acquitted due to lack of evidence.

Pocco court gives man 3 years for abusing 11-yr-old daughter A 38-year-old man was convicted and sentenced to three years rigorous imprisonment by a special Pocco court for sexually abusing his 11-year-old daughter. The abuse started in 2016 and came to light after the child was admitted to the ICU for dengue. Besides the witnesses' testimonies, the court also had a video showing the Shaikh couple making the child toil and then beating him with their daughter standing nearby. The injury marks on the child's body substantiated his allegations of torture.

The court found that the father's conduct did not inspire full confidence about his truthfulness and acquitted three members of the family.
